ACTUAL MISSION: STORM WAS TOO CLOSE TO CUBA TO FLY PATTERN IMMEDIATELY. BEGAN FLYING NW-SE DIAGONALS THRU CENTER UNTIL STORM MOVED FAR ENOUGH FROM CUBA. BEGAN PATTERN WITH N-S AND E-W BOXES AND DIAGONAL PENETRATIONS.
